

## **OUTSTANDING MEMBER AWARD**

### **DESCRIPTION:**

Recognizes outstanding contribution to water supply improvement through desalination and/or water reuse, by an individual who is a member of AMTA.

### **CRITERIA:**

1. Outstanding contribution to improving the nation's water supply through individual effort in the desalting and/or water reuse areas.

#### **Examples include:**

- Contribution to AMTA
  - Contribution to the exchange of information concerning the state of the art of desalination and/or water reuse
  - Contribution to the desalination or water reuse industries
2. Recipient must be an AMTA member.
  3. Award nominations may be submitted by AMTA Affiliate or AMTA Members.
  4. Nominations will be submitted via official nomination form by September 30<sup>th</sup>. This date will be included on the nomination form and available on the AMTA website. The September 30<sup>th</sup> deadline allows the AMTA Board to discuss the Committee's recommendations during the final Board meeting of the calendar year.
  5. Submissions will be reviewed by the AMTA Awards Committee and their recommended awardee will be submitted to the Board for approval at the final Board meeting of the year. Should the Board not reach a consensus during that meeting, the Committee will initiate a Board vote via e-mail with a deadline on or before December 31.

### **AWARD PRESENTATION:**

Award to be presented at the Awards Luncheon during the Membrane Technology Conference or the AMTA Membership meeting. Recipient(s) will receive a plaque.

## **HALL OF FAME AWARD**

### **PIONEERING AND/OR LIFETIME-OF-SERVICE AWARD**

**DESCRIPTION:** Recognizes pioneering and/or lifetime contribution by an individual to water supply improvement and/or reuse technologies utilizing membrane technologies.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Pioneering efforts in research or application to establish water supply improvement and/or reuse technologies; and/or a lifetime of significant contribution in these areas.
2. An individual inducted into AMTA's Hall of Fame may be member or nonmember.
3. Nominations may be submitted by the AMTA Awards Committee or AMTA Members through the official nomination form which will be available on the AMTA website.
4. Nominations will be submitted via official nomination form by September 30<sup>th</sup>. This date will be included on the nomination form and available on the AMTA website. The September 30<sup>th</sup> deadline allows the AMTA Board to discuss the Committee's recommendations during the final Board meeting of the calendar year.
5. Submissions will be reviewed by the AMTA Awards Committee and their recommended awardee will be submitted to the Board for approval at the final Board meeting of the year. Should the Board not reach a consensus during that meeting, the Committee will initiate a Board vote via e-mail with a deadline on or before December 31.

**AWARD PRESENTATION:**

Award to be presented at the Awards Luncheon during the Membrane Technology Conference. Recipient(s) will receive a plaque and a lifetime membership in AMTA as a Division Four (4) member.
